Pastor's Corner

I believe in one God the Father almighty...I believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ...I believe in the Holy Spirit. We say these words every Sunday when we recite the Nicene Creed. It expresses our belief in the Holy Trinity. We attempt to explain the infinite mystery of God using finite human language.

We can never fully comprehend the mystery of God. We do know what God has revealed to us through Jesus Christ. Jesus tells us he was sent by his Father. Jesus was put to death because he claimed to be the Son of God. Jesus promised the gift of the Holy Spirit. We do not believe in 3 Gods. We believe in one God. Yet we hear 3 distinct persons - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The three Persons are profoundly united in one being.

The Church uses a beautiful expression- a communion of Persons. Each one dwells within the other. When we are invited into a relationship with God, we really mean that we are invited into a relationship with each person of the Trinity. We must get to know the Father. We must get to know the Son. We must get to know the Holy Spirit. The next time you pray at home or at Mass ask yourself this question. Who am I praying to? Don't say God. We pray to a person. Who are you talking to? God the Father, Jesus Christ his Son or the Holy Spirit. Reflecting on this reality expands our understanding and experience of God.

There are countless ways to try to explain the Trinity. But we must accept the reality that the Trinity is beyond our grasping. The infinite God cannot be contained in our finite minds. So, we attempt to make comparisons. One of my favorite comparisons is the family. Usually, there is one family that has distinct members of that one family. In the one family of God, there are three distinct divine persons - Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

In the Gospel today, Jesus gives the great commission to his disciples. Go, teach and baptize. When we are baptized we are adopted into the family of God. We are never alone. Our life is about knowing the members of our family more intimately. As we persevere in life let us draw comfort from Jesus' words to all of us - his family members. Memorize the words of Jesus from today's Gospel: **"Behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age."**

Notas del Pastor

Creo en un solo Dios, el Padre Todopoderoso ... Creo en un solo Señor, Jesucristo ... Creo en el Espíritu Santo. Decimos estas palabras todos los domingos cuando recitamos el Credo de Nicea. Expresa nuestra creencia en la Santísima Trinidad. Intentamos explicar el misterio infinito de Dios usando el lenguaje humano finito.

Nunca podemos comprender completamente el misterio de Dios. Sí sabemos lo que Dios nos ha revelado a través de Jesucristo. Jesús nos dice que fue enviado por su Padre. Jesús fue ejecutado porque afirmó ser el Hijo de Dios. Jesús prometió el don del Espíritu Santo. No creemos en 3 dioses. Creemos en un Dios, Sin embargo, escuchamos 3 personas distintas: Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. Las tres personas están profundamente unidas en un solo ser.

La Iglesia usa una hermosa expresión: una comunión de personas. Cada uno habita dentro del otro. Cuando somos invitados a una relación con Dios, realmente queremos decir que estamos invitados a una relación con cada persona de la Trinidad. Debemos llegar a conocer al Padre. Debemos llegar a conocer al Hijo. Debemos conocer al Espíritu Santo. La próxima vez que ore en su casa o en la misa, hágase esta pregunta. ¿A quién le estoy rezando? No digas Dios. Le rezamos a una persona. ¿Con quién estás hablando? Dios el Padre, Jesucristo, su Hijo o el Espíritu Santo. Reflexionando sobre esta realidad expande nuestra comprensión y experiencia de Dios.

Hay innumerables formas de tratar de explicar la Trinidad. Pero debemos aceptar la realidad de que la Trinidad está más allá de nuestro alcance. El Dios infinito no puede estar contenido en nuestras mentes finitas. Entonces, intentamos hacer comparaciones. Una de mis comparaciones favoritas es la familia. Generalmente, hay una familia que tiene miembros distintos de esa familia. En la única familia de Dios, hay tres personas divinas distintas: Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo.

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús da la gran comisión a sus discípulos. Ve, enseña y bautiza. Cuando somos bautizados, somos adoptados en la familia de Dios. Nunca estamos solos Nuestra vida se trata de conocer a los miembros de nuestra familia más íntimamente. Mientras perseveramos en la vida, busquemos consuelo en las palabras de Jesús para todos nosotros, los miembros de su familia. Memorice las palabras de Jesús del Evangelio de hoy: **"He aquí, yo estoy con vosotros todos los días, hasta el fin del mundo".**

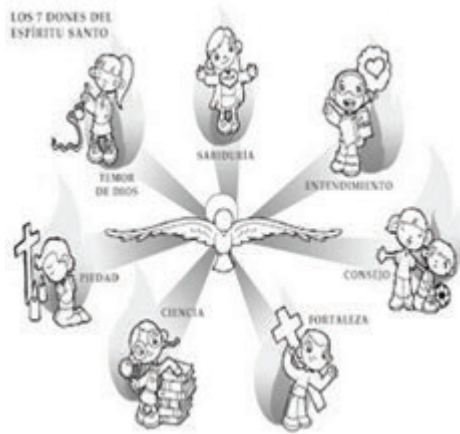
